Gave some influential people shelter, says Bangladesh Army Chief

Bangladesh's Army Chief Gen Waker-Uz-Zaman on Tuesday disclosed that they have given shelter to some influential people of the ousted Awami League government to prevent any attack or extrajudicial action against them.

Speaking at Rajshahi Cantonment, where he met with officials of the army, police, and administration, Gen Zaman said they gave shelter to those people irrespective of their party affiliation, opinion and religion, the Daily Star newspaper reported.

"If there is any allegation against them, any case is filed, they will be punished. But of course, we don't want any attack or extrajudicial action (against them). We have given them shelter because of the threat to their

lives," he said in response to a query.

His comments came on a day when former law minister Anisul Huq and Salman F Rahman, private industry and investment affairs adviser to the former prime minister Sheikh Hasina, were arrested in Dhaka.

Former foreign minister Hassan Mahmud and ex-state minister Zunaid Ahmed Palak were arrested last week at the Dhaka airport while attempting to flee the country after Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina resigned and fled the country following deadly protests against her government.

According to reports, several top leaders and lawmakers of Hasina's Awami League and cabinet ministers have left the country. Several other ministers left their official or private residences and are believed to be hiding in safe places.

B'desh interim govt urges people to provide info about attacks

Bangladesh's interim government has set up a hotline asking people to provide information about attacks on Hindu temples, churches or any other religious institutions, amid reports of vandalisation of religious places, businesses and properties of minorities following the ouster of prime minister Sheikh Hasina.

The Ministry of Religious Affairs has requested to provide information about attacks on religious institutions, Bengali language daily Prothom Alo reported on Tuesday.

"If a temple, church, pagoda or any other religious institution is attacked or attacked by miscreants, it is requested to report its information by calling this mobile number 01766-843809 or by sending a small message," the paper reported, citing

a notification issued by the ministry on Monday.

Religious Affairs Adviser to the interim government AFM Khalid Hossain has condemned recent attacks on religious institutions belonging to minorities.

During a press briefing at the secretariat on Monday, Khalid confirmed that complaints had been received about attacks on minority homes and religious sites. He assured ongoing sup-

port for these communities.

Hossain announced that deputy commissioners are compiling a list of damages.

On Tuesday, interim government's Chief Adviser Muhammad Yunus reached out to the distressed Hindu community members and assured them that his government would punish those responsible for attacks on the minorities.

Yunus, 84, who took charge as the Chief Ad-

visor on Thursday, visited the Dhakeshwari National Temple where he urged the people to "exercise patience" before judging his government.

"Rights are equal for everyone. We are all one people with one right. Do not make any distinctions among us. Please, assist us. Exercise patience, and later judge -- what we were able to do and not. If we fail, then criticise us," Yunus said.

He exchanged greetings with the leaders of Bangladesh Puja Udjapan Parishad and Mahanagar Sarbojanin Puja Committee, as well as officials from the temple management board and devotees.

"We congratulated Dr Yunus on assuming office. We had a cordial meeting with him," President Puja Udjapan Parishad Basudeb Dhar said when asked about the meeting with the chief adviser.

Sheikh Hasina demands 'justice'

Bangladesh's deposed prime minister Sheikh Hasina on Tuesday demanded "justice," saying those involved in recent "terror acts", killings and vandalism must be investigated, identified and punished.

In her first public statement after her ouster on August 5, 76-year-old Hasina said several lives have been lost in violence in the name of agitation since July. "I express grief at the deaths of students, teachers, police personnel, pregnant women, journalists, cultural activists, working people, leaders and workers of the Awami League," said Hasina.

SAARC Secy-Gen meets Nepal's Foreign Minister

KATHMANDU: Secretary-General of the SAARC Md Golam Sarwar on Tuesday called on Nepal's Foreign Minister Arzu Rana Deuba and the two leaders discussed the current state of cooperation in the eight-member regional grouping and revitalising the forum in the shared interests of member states. The SAARC or South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation has not been very effective since 2016 as its biennial summits have not taken place since the last one in Kathmandu in 2014. **PTI**

ANKARA: A teenager wearing a helmet and bulletproof vest randomly stabbed five people at an open-air cafe in northwest Turkey before being detained by police, officials and media reports said Tuesday. The 18-year-old, identified as Arda K., broadcast Monday's knife attack on social media through a camera attached to his vest, HaberTurk television reported. **AP**

Russia vows strong retaliation over Ukraine's attack

Ukraine's attacks on Russia's border will receive a "worthy response," with the Russian military's primary task being to remove the Ukrainian forces from Russian territories, President Vladimir Putin said Monday.

"The enemy will certainly receive a worthy response, and all the goals facing us will undoubtedly be achieved," Putin said at an operational meeting via videoconference on the situation in the border regions.

Ukrainian forces crossed the Russian border last Tuesday and broke into parts of Russia's Kursk region. Currently, the Ukrainian military holds 28 settlements in the area, according

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky on Monday confirmed that Ukraine is carrying out an "operation" in the region.

"Commander-in-Chief Oleksandr Syrsky reported on our defensive actions

on the front and our operation in the Kursk region," Zelensky wrote on Telegram. The Ukrainian leader also said that he instructed the country's Security Service, Interior Minister Ihor Klymenko and other officials to prepare a humanitarian plan.

Kwatra is India's new Ambassador to US

Vinay Mohan Kwatra has assumed charge as India's Ambassador to the US here and vowed that he and his team will continue to work intensely to strengthen the crucial partnership.

Kwatra, 61, who retired as India's Foreign Secretary on July 14, arrived here in the US capital on Monday.

He succeeds Taranjit Singh Sandhu, who retired from the foreign service early this year and served as India's top diplomat in the US from 2020 to 2024. "Privileged to assume charge as the Ambassador of India to the United States of America. Team @IndianEmbassyUS will continue to work intensely," Kwatra said.

The Indian visa application centre here resumed "limited operations" on Tuesday, days after Bangladesh saw violent clashes which led to the ouster of prime minister Sheikh Hasina.

Hasina, 76, resigned and fled to India last week following widespread protests against her Awami League-led government over a controversial job quota system.

Indian Visa Application Centre (IVAC) has announced the resumption of limited operations in its Dhaka centre.

"IVAC (JFP) Dhaka has resumed limited operations. Messages will be sent to individual applicants regarding (the) collection of passports," the press release said.

Ship in Red Sea attacked three times by suspected Yemeni rebels

A Liberian-flagged oil tanker in the Red Sea came under attack three times on Tuesday, including in an assault using a bomb-carrying drone boat, likely the latest in a campaign by Yemen's Houthi rebels over the Israel-Hamas war, officials said.

The attacks come as the rebels' main sponsor, Iran, weighs possible retaliation against Israel over the assassination of Hamas official Ismail Haniyeh last month in Tehran, Iran's capital, which has renewed fears of a wider regional war in the Middle East. Already, the Houthi as-

saults have disrupted the \$1 trillion annual flow of goods through the maritime route crucial to trade among Asia, Europe and the Middle East, while also sparking the most intense combat for the US Navy since World War II. The Greek-managed Delta Atlantica was first at-

tacked when two explosives detonated near it, according to the Joint Maritime Information Centre, a multinational force overseen by the US Navy. A small ship "flashing lights" at the vessel had come close to the loaded tanker bound for Greece during the incident,

the Center said. A small ship later flashed lights at the Delta Atlantica before another explosion near it, the Center said.

The third attack happened hours later on Tuesday, some 180 kilometers (110 miles) northwest of the Houthi-held port city Hodeida, prompting an armed security force aboard the tanker to open fire.

"The vessel was approached by an uncrewed surface vessel on the starboard side. The USV collided with the vessel but did not detonate," the center said. "Subsequently, the armed security team disabled the USV via small arms fire."
